WORK ATTIRE OF PLAINCLOTHES INVESTIGATORS

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this procedure is to establish an appropriate policy regarding the work attire of plainclothes investigators of this Department.

POLICY

Acceptable attire consists of one of the following:

1. Suit, dress shirt, and tie.
2. Sportcoat, dress shirt, tie, and dress trousers.
3. Leisure suit of formal or semi-formal style.
4. Casual sports clothes in good taste.

SPECIAL ASSIGNMENTS

Certain assignments, such as surveillances and undercover operations, do not lend themselves to such attire as discussed in this procedure. Thus, personnel assigned to such duties may be exempted from the provisions of this procedure in specific cases by the Division Commander.

"ON-CALL" INVESTIGATORS

Investigative personnel assigned to "on-call" status shall be attired in the above fashion regardless of the time of day or night that they are required to respond.
