VEHICLE CODE EQUIPMENT CITATIONS

## INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this procedure is to specify the manner in which violations of the listed equipment sections of the Vehicle Code should be cited.

## SECTIONS COVERED

As specified in Section 40303.5 of the California Vehicle Code, the following violations may be addressed with a corrective citation:

- Any registration <u>infraction</u> set forth in Division 3 (commencing with Section 4000),
- Any driver's license <u>infraction</u> set forth in Division 6 (commencing with Section 12500) and Subdivision (a) of Section 12951, relating to possession of driver's license.
- 3. Section 21291, relating to bicycle equipment.
- 4. Any <u>infraction</u> involving equipment set forth in Division 2 (commencing with Section 24000).

## CITATION FORM

The violator should be issued a standard Barstow Police Department citation filling in all appropriate sections. The violator's date to appear shall be no less than 30 days from the date the citation is issued. (Exception: In certain instances, if the officer believes that the violation renders a vehicle unsafe for use on a public roadway, the officer may issue a 48 hour notice to appear).
