SUBJECT: COVID-19 PRESS RELEASE

On March 19, 2020, Governor Gavin Newsom issued a stay at home order to protect the health and well-being of all Californians and to establish consistency across the state in order to slow the spread of COVID-19. The order is in place until further notice. More information on what residents should or should not do is available here www.covid19.ca.gov.

Essential services in Barstow will remain open including, gas stations, pharmacies, grocery stores, farmers markets, food banks, convenience stores, take-out and delivery restaurants, banks and laundromats/laundry services.

Essential state and local government functions will also remain open, including law enforcement and offices that provide government programs and services. All City buildings will continue to be closed to the public however essential City staff are working and available by phone or email.
