**Q:** When will the asphalt on the First Street Bridge north end sidewalk (coming up from the Harvey House) be repaired?

**A:** **The north end (asphalt) sidewalk will be assessed to see what improvements are financially viable.**

### 11. INSTALLATION SUPPORT SERVICES - PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT

CARMEN HERNANDEZ, BARSTOW, CALIFORNIA

**Q:** How many government pass-thru contracts does the City currently have?

**A:** **The City has four Inter-Government Support Agreements (IGSA) for services such as sampling, uniforms, propane, animal control and base operations.**

**Q:** Did the Finance Director conduct an analysis on staff time and cost to manage the IGSA?

**A:** **Minimal staff time is needed once the IGSA is fully executed and in place.**

**Q:** How much revenue would the City receive annually?

**A:** **The City will receive \$6 million over the IGSA's 10-year term (\$600,000 annually).**

**Q: Who is High Desert Support Services?**

**A: High Desert Support Services is a Louisiana limited liability corporation that has been providing installation support services at Fort Irwin for approximately ten years.**
