Free Drop Off at Burrtec

- Up to 4 tires per year, per household (with or without rims) can be taken to Burrtec's Drop Off Collection Center Monday - Friday 8am-5pm and Saturday 8am-12pm

- Contact Burrtec at 760.256.2730 beforehand for official rules.

Free Dump Day Events

- Take up to 9 standard size tires (with or without rims) to the Free Dump Day & Shred Fest Events.
- Events are held twice per year, typically in April and October on the 3rd Saturday of the month.

Curbside Pickup

- Tires are eligible for curbside pickup as part of the residential bulky item pickup program.
- Limited number of tires are accepted (4 tires, once per year, per household).
- A scheduled appointment is required.
- Please DO NOT leave tires at the curb without scheduling a pickup; it could leave you subject to enforcement action.
- To schedule a pickup or find out what restrictions may apply, contact 760.255.5162.

Did you know?

Tires collected under our residential programs are recycled into flooring and other products!

Resources for Businesses

Tire Management Basics

- Businesses generating waste tires are required to file for a Tire Program Identification Number (TPID).
- State law requires any person who transports more than 9 used tires to hold a valid Waste Tire Hauler Registration.
- Any person who stores or stockpiles large volumes of tires at a specific location may be required to obtain a Waste Tire Facility Permit with the State.
