


Barstow is a community where visitors explore, workers reside and raise their families and children grow up to find jobs at livable wages, enabling them to remain in the community to develop their own households.

 Goals, policies, and maps to guide decisions when evaluating projects and investments

 Actions to identify next steps for implementation





#### **Potential Growth**


Barstow has the potential to roughly double in size over the next 25 years
















annexed, The diagram conveys the City's equivalent and/or desired future land use.

#### **CEQA Environmental Analysis**

#### California Environmental Quality Act



CEQA is a process to inform decision makers and public about possible impacts of a decision on the environment



CEQA is also a process to identify feasible ways to mitigate such impacts and evaluate alternatives



EIR evaluates the projected growth through 2048 compared to what is on the ground today




Topics ranging from air quality to hydrology to transportation
